Where other books recite deeds or wills, this book recites names. This single book, in reality, could be rearranged in as many as six separate book. There are histories, genealogies, census lists, biographies, Town Records and County Records. Interested readers should note that Prentice Glazier did very little research in Maine and tells us so in his great work, Chamberlain Families in New England and New York.*
